9.30 am Depart Country Club Tasmania and travel by coach into the Tamar Valley Wine Route visiting the following vineyards and sampling the many varieties of cool climate wines.

10.00 am **Josef Chromy Wines**

The Josef Chromy cellar door, vineyard and winery is located at Relbia, a fifteen minute drive south of Launceston in Northern Tasmania and just a short distance from the Launceston Airport.

The estate includes a 61 hectare (150 acre) vineyard and newly completed state of the art winery, producing elegant wines from premium cool climate fruit. Varieties grown include Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Riesling, Gewurtz Traminer and Pinot Noir. Josef Chromy Wines also make a premium sparkling wine and Botrytis Riesling

11.30 am **Janz**

With red basalt soil and a cool climate moderated by the proximity of Bass Strait, the Jansz Tasmania vineyards are ideal for allowing grapes to ripen slowly and to develop the lingering acidity essential in a premium sparkling wine. Tasmania's first dedicated sparkling wine vineyard, Jansz has become known as the benchmark Australian sparkling wine producer.

12.15 pm **Bay of Fires Winery**

Bay of Fires was born of a desire to make cool climate wines of classical structure, combining fruit intensity with refinement, complexity and persistence of flavour. The vineyards growing grapes for Bay of Fires wines experience growing season temperatures ranging from below those of Reims in Champagne to slightly above those of Burgundy and Alsace. Bay of Fires, Tigress and Arras have evolved from their understanding of Tasmania's unique vineyards.
